DÉCORS & PANORAMIQUES

Not only the pattern appeals to the imagination, the material used is also surprising. From velvety soft silk looks and bouclé fabrics to sophisticated linen effects.

"Décors" are lavish images that make a statement on the wall. These eye-catchers are easy to use in any room. The scenes of the "Panoramiques" are artistic gems and always consist of several panels that together form one panoramic whole.

DIORÉ

Dioré is a wonderful print on a high-pile textile. It is a contemporary, more abstract interpretation of classic tapestries. Thanks to the high quality of the textile and the colour nuances in the design, this wallcovering can barely be distinguished from a hand-tufted carpet. The design owes its name to the protected Forêt de Dioré on the island of Réunion.

MONTANA

This exceptional Art Deco wallcovering combines several weaving techniques to form an exceptional geometric design. Montana is partly embroidered on a luxurious jacquard textile, whilst other elements are created using velvet appliqué to create drama and depth.

SELAS

This décor's retro vibe featuring geometric half-moons is unmistakable. Named after the Greek word selas, meaning light, brightness, glow, the design combines two types of embroidery on a linen and viscose base: the crescent moon embroidery beautifully contrasts the tight vertical stripes.

BALATA GARDEN

Inspired by the extraordinary botanical diversity of the Balata Garden on the island of Martinique, this tropical décor captures the atmosphere of lush, exotic foliage. The fluidity of the design combines with the soft textile finish to create a captivating and powerful design statement.

FORÊT DES MUSES

French and English gardens, with their abundance of botanical diversity, served as the model for this exuberant décor. The painterly design comes to life on the linen-look fabric, while the underlying foil adds a radiant shimmer.

CHINTZ

This colourful wallcovering plays with exuberant chalk lines and rhythm.
Chintz is finished in a shiny fil-à-fil textile.

Tropical flowers and plants such as the South African sugar bush, leopard lily and a blooming pineapple take you on an exotic journey.

SIERRA NEVADA

This décor draws inspiration from the majestic Sierra Nevada. Distinctly North American motifs of mountain peaks, eagles and wildflowers are artfully arranged in a stylised pattern. The design is brought to life with a luxurious jacquard bouclé weave.

ALL'OMBRA DEI CIPRESSI

This décor illustrates a Tuscan landscape with rounded shapes.
The velvety chenille finish completes the picture.

FILIGRANA

A stunning embroidered wallcovering in true Art Deco style. The name 'Filigrana' references the extremely delicate, fine filigree wire work patterns created by artisanal goldsmiths. Embroidered onto a warm blend of cotton and linen, this design brings both graphic drama and tactile intimacy to an interior.

ORNEMENT

The abstract floral richness of the Ornement décor captivates through its exceptional cross-stitch embroidery. This rendering of an 18th-century tapestry is revitalised on a luxurious, ultra-soft velour, adding depth and tactile allure to the design.

BROCADE

The Brocade décor is derived from an early 20th century textile. Its refined motif, rich in detail and texture, is revived on a luxurious jacquard fabric, preserving the grandeur and elegance of the original pattern.

BOUQUET

This beautiful décor, aptly named Bouquet, is designed after a historic tapestry from the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam. The design comes to life on a slightly textured textile, whose airy, open weave lends the composition a calming and natural appearance.

RIVERBANK

This woven jacquard wallcovering depicts a lush riverbank where a Japanese crane, a rare species regarded as a symbol of good fortune, appears among the vegetation. The subtly pixelated drawing nods to the optimism of technological progress associated with mid-century Japanese aesthetics.

RAMAGE

In the world of textile design, a ramage denotes a motif of branches and flowers — an apt name for this décor in a Japanese drawing style, where birds of paradise hide playfully among lush foliage. The luxurious jacquard textile lends the composition a classical, enduring elegance.

The Collines décor is derived from an authentic 18th-century tapestry from Aubusson. Its abstract botanical motif is distinctly timeless, making it perfectly suited to contemporary interiors while preserving the charm of its historic origins.

ZERZURA

The legend of Zerzura tells the story of a fertile oasis in the desert west of the Nile, of which its existence was never proven. This mythical scene is brought beautifully to life on a velvet background.

Rovine is a stately panoramic in vinyl that imitates an etching of a Greek ruin. The drawing shows antiquity in decay. The work is dedicated to Monsieur Descamps, one of the king's artists.

Yasuni National Park in Ecuador is one of the most biodiverse places on earth and truly captures the imagination. This special place lent its name and inspiration to the Yasuni panorama. The tropical design is composed of short, sharp lines, creating a strong graphic effect that is brought to life by rich, warm colours and a soft velvet finish.

MILK AND HONEY

A paradise scene that makes you dream away. Hummingbirds, parrots and monkeys live harmoniously in the land of milk and honey. This panoramic is printed on a background with a parchment paper look for an unmatched vintage effect.

SECRET SILHOUETTES

Mysterious, feminine silhouettes look at you and transport you into a fantastical story. This dreamy scene with its rounded shapes appeals to the imagination, rather like a painting. The soft chenille material used suits this panoramic perfectly.

RÊVERIE TROPICALE

A dreamy panoramic view that takes you to higher realms. Who wouldn't want to spend some time amid the lush foliage of this gorgeous oasis? The detail in this design is impressive, but upon closer inspection the subtle woven grass print in the background suddenly catches the eye, adding a natural accent to the design and the material on which it has been printed.

PARADISIAC

The dreamy panorama Paradisiac depicts a tropical oil painting. This heavenly scene featuring a memorising tropical landscape is printed on ultra-soft velvet, giving it a refined, tactile appearance.

SUNDARA

The richly detailed panorama Sundara draws inspiration from the Indian region of Rajasthan, celebrated for its stunning landscapes and colourful palaces. Aptly named Sundara, a Sanskrit word meaning beautiful, noble, and beauty. The luxurious fil-à-fil textile finish and warm colours enhance the lush appearance of this enchanting design.

ESCAPADE

The Escapade panorama, designed after a late-18th-century tapestry, evokes the atmosphere of a painted scene. It reveals a dreamy natural landscape that invites the viewer to wander and drift away, while the velvety-soft textile heightens the sense of luxury and elegance.

FLORAISON

With its ornate frame, Floraison recalls the character of a classical painting. It is designed after an original 18th-century tapestry from Aubusson, and the composition draws the viewer almost irresistibly into the scene. The panorama is executed on a parchment-like base, emphasising the authentic origin of the drawing.

RÉCOLTE DES FLEURS

The Récolte des Fleurs panorama, designed after an antique Beauvais tapestry, depicts a lively and joyful scene. The flower pickers celebrate life with an infectious energy that seems to radiate from the design. Rendered on a parchment-like base, the work glows like a precious artefact that has gracefully withstood the test of time.
